- Q1. What is Intensive Course?

- A1. Intensive Course is a short-term concentrated course, ideal for students and businessperson who want to practice Korean language skill (Listening and Speaking) but cannot spend long time to do.

- Q2. Does intensive Course have same curricular as regular courses?

- A2. Unlike regular courses, intensive course run only one week or two weeks. For student study in depth or develop writing skill, we recommend to enroll regular courses.

Airport Bus: 17,000 Korean Won (About 12 Dollars)

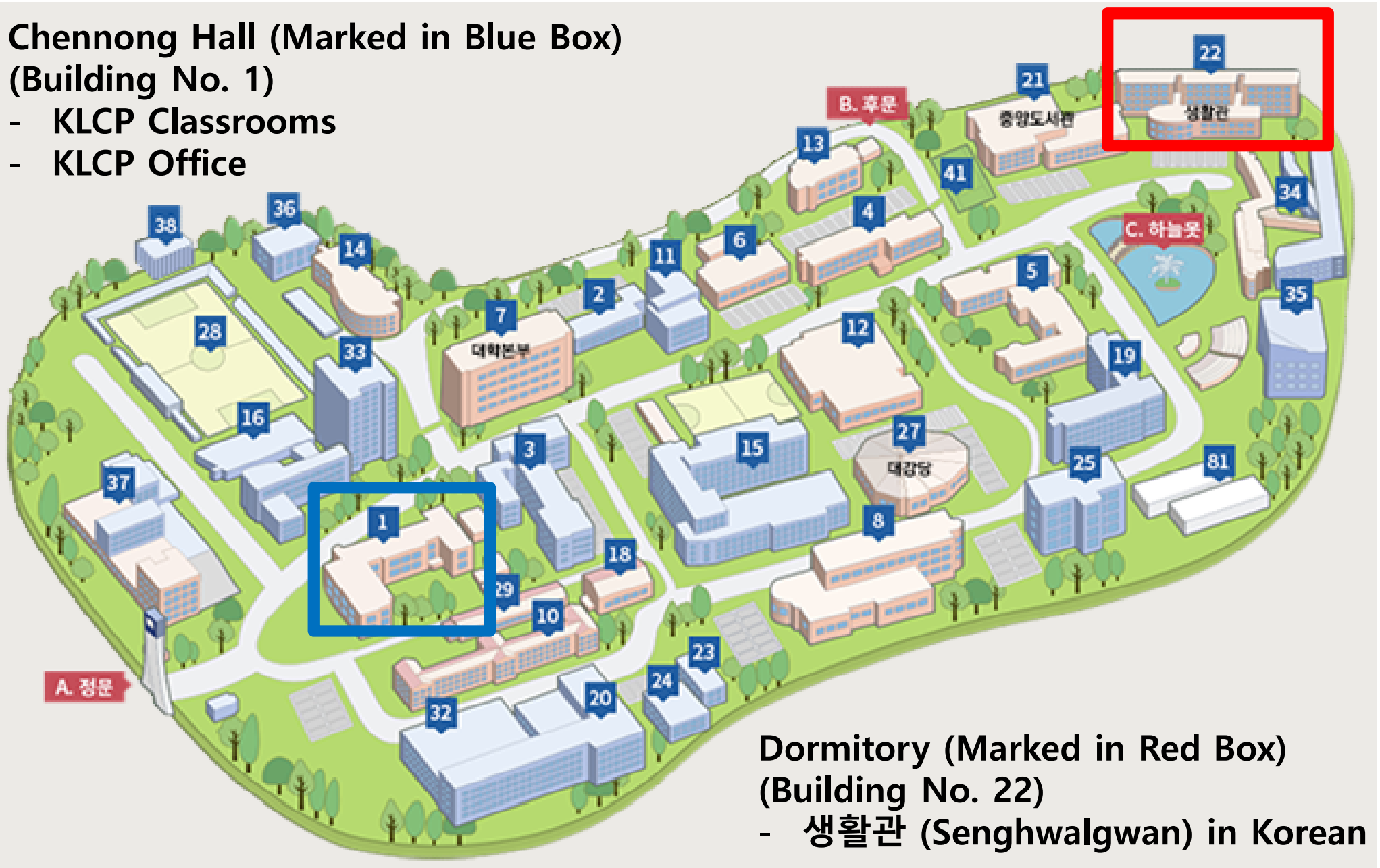
Taxi: 62,400 Korean Won (About 46 US Dollars)
