(Arrive on 25 July: kick-off rally during 18:00-19:00 JST and Depart on 10 August)

* Before the arrival to Japan, participants need to take the online placement test for the Japanese language classes. Instructions will be given later by Kyoto University after students are being selected.

ILAS Program 2024 - English programme

Tuition Fee

Waived for selected CUHK students. Students shall take care of the rest of the expenses which include but not limited to the flight tickets, travel insurance (mandatory) and visa (if applicable).

Scholarship

Kyoto University offers a scholarship of JPY30,000 (per student) as a subsidy for staying in the designated accommodation.

Designated Accommodation

Quota

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Eligibility

- All local undergraduate students who have completed at least two academic terms of study at CUHK (not eligible for students' expected graduation date on or before 31 July 2024) prior to participation in Kyoto Summer Program 2024
- Excellent academic performance
- Good English language proficiency
- Preference will be given to students who have never studied Japanese language and never been to Japan.

Complete and submit the webform by 5 May 2024 (Sunday)

Interview

Shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend an interview on 16 May 2024 (Thursday) afternoon at YIA.

Programme Content

This year's program consists of a kick-off rally, opening ceremony & orientation, a campus tour, Kyoto U introduction, 12 academic lectures, 5 Japanese language classes offered at 5 levels, one fieldtrip, Japanese cultural activities, discussion sessions in English, conversation sessions with Kyoto U students in Japanese, lab visits, a final presentation, a completion ceremony, a farewell party, and other student planned activities.

Attendance

Participants are expected to attend the whole programme actively, including at least 8 out of 12 academic lectures and other mandatory sessions.

Certificates

Participants will receive a Certificate of Participation and Academic Transcripts from Kyoto U upon completion of the program. Note that Academic Transcripts will NOT be issued to those who fail to attend the required mandatory sessions.
