Visit historic neighborhoods, hike through iconic landscapes and check out historic landmarks such as the Golden Gate Bridge, Alcatraz Embarcadero and Nob Hill. Students pay the following tuition and mandatory fees per semester:

- Tuition: \$395 per unit x number of units enrolled
- Mandatory fees (Undergraduate and Graduate, Non-Business): \$165 per unit x number of units enrolled
- Mandatory fees (Graduate, Business): \$405 per unit x number of units enrolled
