Mrs. Choy Wei Oi Yuk Memorial Scholarship 2024/25

Objective

The award is to recognize students who have conducted useful research into a specific area of Hong Kong History with significant achievement or implication for future study.

Number of Award and Eligibility

One award of HK\$4,000 will be given. Undergraduate students from any discipline and any year of study can apply individually or in small groups.

Selection Criteria

The research must be completed within the preceding 12 months when the application for the award is submitted. It should demonstrate usefulness in providing insights into an area of Hong Kong History and/or contribute to helping others understand and appreciate Hong Kong History.

Application Procedures

1. Open application and nomination are both welcome. The applicant can be nominated by a project supervisor from the CUHK.
2. A written report is required at the time of application to cover rationale, research nature, methodology, findings, conclusion, evaluation etc.
3. Selection interview may be required.

Application Guidelines

1. Applicants are required to complete and submit the online application form <https://cloud.itsc.cuhk.edu.hk/webform/view.php?id=13704611> on or before 11:59pm, 12 May 2025 (Monday).
 2. Print out the application form in PDF format received via CUHK email address, together with the following required supporting documents, submit to Information Counter at LG1, Wen Lan Tang, Shaw College on or before 4:00pm, 15 May 2025 (Thursday).
 - 2.1 Unofficial transcript as at Term 1, 2024/25; and
 - 2.2 Written report and research project.
 3. A recommendation letter is required. You may invite the referee to send the recommendation separately to the Secretary of Scholarship, Award and Financial Assistance Committee.
 4. Deadline for online application is **11:59pm, 12 May 2025 (Monday)**.
 5. Deadline for submitting supporting documents is **4:00pm, 15 May 2025 (Thursday)**.
- Late and/or incomplete application will NOT be considered.
