Mrs. Tsao Chan Wai Ping Memorial Scholarship 2020/21

Objective

The award is to recognize students who have conducted useful research in the area of Greater China Region (i.e. Hong Kong, China, Taiwan and/or Macau) with significant achievement or implication for future study.

Number of Award and Eligibility

One award of HK\$4,000 will be given. Undergraduate students from any discipline and any year of study can apply individually or in small groups. Student(s) can only submit application for this scholarship for the same research once, and they should perform reasonably well academically.

Selection Criteria

The research must be conducted and completed during students' undergraduate studies at CUHK. It should demonstrate usefulness in providing insights into the research area and/or contribute to helping others understand more about the area related to Greater China Region.

Application Procedures

1. Open application and nomination are both welcome. The applicant can be nominated by a project supervisor from the CUHK.
2. A written report is required at the time of application to cover rationale, research nature, methodology, findings, conclusion, evaluation etc.
3. Selection interview may be required.

2. A recommendation letter is welcome. You may invite the referee to send the recommendation separately to the Secretary of Scholarship, Award and Financial Assistance Committee.

4. The application form and all supporting documents should be in ONE pdf file and file size limited to 10MB.
